

PCC – Welcome Letter 2013/14



WELCOME TO PENINSULA CRICKET 2013/14

Here at the Peninsula Cricket Club [PCC] we provide cricket for boys and girls of any ability from ages of 5 to 17. Below is a summary of the different games:-

In2CRICKET

This is a fun, skills-based program to introduce boys and girls from 5 to 8 years of age to the game of cricket. A range of activities are conducted each session, using plastic bats, stumps and soft balls. Our nine week program will commence in Term 4 and will run on a Friday after school for about 1½ hours. The kids will receive a Participation Pack [Bag, Bat, Ball T-Shirt, Hat and more] and each child will be in with a chance to play on the SCG during the New Year's test at the SCG. Kanga Cricket

This year sees another year of Kanga cricket at PCC. It is designed for children who may have had one season of In2Cricket but are not yet eligible to play U9s. All players get to bat, bowl and wicket-keep and there are **unlimited outs**. The result is based on an average of the total score divided by the wickets lost. The games last between 1 to 2 hours and are always played on a Saturday morning.

Average Cricket

This is played by Under 9's, 10's and 11/Div.2. All players get to bat, bowl and wicket-keep and there are **unlimited outs**. The result is based on an average of the total score divided by the wickets lost. The kids wear protective gear and the games are played on proper pitches with shortened lengths to suit their ability. The games last between 1½ to 2½ hours and are always played on a Saturday morning.

Traditional Cricket

This is played by Under 11/Div.1 and up with both one and two day games. This is the real game and the proper rules apply – hence, batsmen are only out once! The games typically start at 8:30am and will finish around Noon. One day games may start earlier.

Representative Cricket

For kids in Under 11's and up, Representative Cricket is available for Manly Warringah Junior Cricket Association [MWJCA]. The season runs between October and December and all games are played on Sundays – The kids are still expected to play for their club on the Saturday.

Uniforms

All players other than in2CRICKET are expected to wear our club uniform. It consists of a club shirt with the club emblem, plain white shorts or long pants, a club hat or cap and white socks. If cold weather, players can wear a white jumper or Sloppy Joe. All clothing except for pants and socks can be purchased through the club. We strongly request that parents make every effort to get their kids dressed appropriately for match day as this creates a sense of identity, unity and pride at a team and club level.

Rules

A copy of the rules must be at each match and kept with the Manager. They should be referred to the Club if any dispute occurs during a match. For more info, see www.manlyjuniorcricket.nsw.cricket.com.au/
